PROCEEDINGS: **Granting of Preliminary Injunction**
[In Chambers]

Plaintiffs' motion for preliminary injunction is GRANTED, in part. The Court will issue a more formal opinion and order later today stating the ruling on the injunction. Because time is of the essence, the parties are now notified that the Court's order will contain the following provisions:

1. The Court does not enjoin the ABA or its House from calendaring or voting on the Western State issue. The ABA may continue its normal process, if it wishes.
2. The Court does preliminarily enjoin the ABA from implementing any final decision to withdraw Western's provisional accreditation or remove Western from the list of approved law schools.
3. No bond is required.
4. The Court will accelerate litigation of this matter, to decide the final injunction issue within a matter of weeks.
